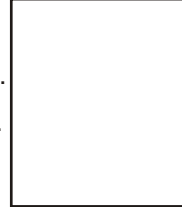

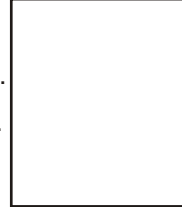

General Information

Brief History of the school

1. Army School, Itarana (Alwar) was established in the year 1981 in the form of a Nursery school, and was upgraded to the primary level in the year 1990. The school was converted to Army school with the approval of Army HQ on 14 June 1991.
2. The School was recognized by Central Board of Secondary Education. New Delhi (CBSE) on 22 June 2001 (Affiliation No. 1780018). Army School Itarana was redesignated as Army Public School, Alwar on 01 April 2008. At Present, the school is running classes upto XII standard with Science, Commerce and Humanities stream. The first batch of std. XII appeared for CBSE AISSE examination 2015.

Army Public School, Alwar is an English Medium Co-Educational Institution founded under the aegis of Army Welfare Education Society (AWES). The medium of instruction is fundamentally English and great importance is laid on fluency in spoken English with correct pronunciation and diction. Hindi is taught as a National language with equal importance.

School Diary

Students are required to bring the school Diary to School every day. The School diary is used as a medium to establish a valuable understanding between parents and teachers. While the teachers are instructed to make the relevant entries in it from time to time, Parents are requested to refer to it everyday to keep in touch with their ward's progress. GENERAL GUIDELINES

For Parents / Guardians and Students

The school lays stress on perfect discipline at all times, in the school and even outside. Disregard of authority and rules are viewed seriously and are considered as a breach of the school discipline.

Immorality, insubordination, contempt of the authorities and neglect of studies are sufficient reasons inviting serious and immediate disciplinary action. The school reserves the right of not readmitting a student whose progress is constantly unsatisfactory or whose conduct is likely to be a bad influence on other students and the school. Parents/Guardians are requested to follow the under mentioned guidelines :

1. Parents are requested to encourage self-help in work and study at home. Children should be encouraged to do their own work like polishing the shoes, making their beds, Keeping things tidily and with care. The Formation of such habits early in life inculcates in them the idea of dignity of labour and a feeling of self reliance.
2. Parents are advised to co-operate with the school in the attempt to help their child's progress by paying attention to their being regular, punctual and disciplined by taking interest in their homework and following other instructions in their school diaries. In case of small children, parents are requested to check their bags regularly to see if any notice or other circular has been issued.
3. Parents are advised to inculcate among their children good behaviour, moral values and good habits so that they are not only recognized by the uniform they wear but by their behaviour and conduct as a student of Army Public School.
4. Parents should take pride in their ward (s) is/are studying in the Army Public School, which is one of the best institutions. This will go a long way in developing a sense of pride in their wards.
5. Parents/Guardians should not enter the classrooms to see their ward (s) or the teacher while classes are in progress. If there is any legitimate complaint, please meet the Principal or write to him / her in a separate letter. He/ She will look in to the matter personally.
6. Parents are advised not to criticize any teacher of the school in the presence of their children as it causes them to loss respect for their teachers, with the consequent failure to learn from them. It also further retards their progress.
7. No gifts should be given to the teachers by the parents.
8. Parents are requested not to approach Army Public School teachers for private tutitions.
9. Leave for half day should not be asked for. In an emergency, written permission must be taken from the principal and the class teacher. The bus in charge should also be informed accordingly.
10. Children will not be dispersed from the school with anybody other than the parents/guardians. In case, they are unable to come themselves, the nominated person must produce a written authority letter signed by the parents/guardian.
11. They should immediately inform the school regarding any change in their address or telephone numbers.
12. Parents must attend the Parents - Teachers Meetings. In case they are likely to be out of station prior information in writing should be sent.

- (a) Students suffering from any contagious disease will not be allowed to sit in the class or mix with other students. Parents are advised not to send their ward to school till the infection subsides.
 - (b) Students suffering from any chronic disease should give a letter to the effect to the class teacher. The school will not be responsible for any contingencies arising on this account.
14. All students are expected to maintain silence in the classroom, academic area or while going for various activities.
 15. Children attending school without proper uniform, untidy in person / dress, or boys with unkept hair will not be allowed to attend classes. Fine as decided from time to time will be imposed for absence without leave and late comers will be sent back.
 16. If a child is caught using unfair means in any examination / class test, he / she will be awarded a 'zero' in the particular examination.
 17. Under no circumstances a retest will be conducted.
 18. Care must be taken of all school properties as any damage caused by a student will be recovered from concerned students. Disciplinary action will be initiated and monetary fines may also be imposed for the offence.
 19. Ragging in any form is prohibited and will lead to the expulsion of the student.
 20. Students failing to return library books on the due date will have to pay a fine of Rs 2/- per book / per day till they return the book, Defacements / damage of library books will invite strict disciplinary action / or fines.
 21. The name, house / admission number , Class, Section of the students should be clearly marked on the belongings such as bags, blazers, jerseys, tiffin boxes water bottles etc. of the children.
 22. Parents are advised to grant money to their children very judiciously.
 23. All students are prohibited from using motor bikes / scooters / scooties to commute to school
 - (a) In case they do so, the vehicle will not be allowed inside the school premises. Safety of such a vehicle will be the responsibility of the students himself.
 - (b) If a student is found driving a powered vehicle without proper valid driving license the vehicle will be confiscated and disciplinary action will be initiated against the student.
 24. Parents are advised to ensure that their children do not bring valuable articles like mobile phones, cameras, I-pods, flash drivers, CDs/ DVDs, gold chains, jewellery etc. Items as mentioned above, if found in possession of the student will be confiscated,. In case of any loss of any such article in the school, the authorities will not be held responsible for the loss.
 25. In case B-certificate for claims has to be signed; it should be left at the counter and collected the next day. Photo copy of fee slip should be attached along with the claim. Parents/ Guardians are requested not to insist on documentation on the same day.
 26. Parents / Guardians must ensure that they are punctual in remitting the school fees. In case the fees is not paid in the same quarter, the name of the student will be struck of the rolls. Under such circumstances readmission will have to be sought after clearing old dues and paying all admission dues as applicable for readmission.
 27. If a cheque deposited in the bank towards payment of any school dues, is dishonored for whatsoever reason including depositor's bank error, a fine of Rs 100/- will be levied per transaction.
